

Enclose with your application

- Original passport photo (full-face) with your last and first name written on the reverse side. If selected as recipient, photo will be posted on the website of the Catholic League for Religious Assistance to Poland and Polonia. Must be actual photo, not photocopy. No substitutions or variations will be accepted by the Committee
- Current official transcript of your academic record
- Your essay, in English or Polish (see more details below in this Application)
- Recommendation letter detailing your parish involvement and Mass attendance from your Pastor of a financially supportive parish/mission.
- Additional recommendation letters, on official letterhead, describing your parish and community involvement, moral demeanor, and spiritual formation. Letters cannot be from family members.
- Copy of your parents' latest Federal Income Tax Return.
- Declaration page – signed and dated by the applicant.

Eligibility Requirements

- Proof of U.S. citizenship or permanent residency (US passport page with name/photo or green card)
- Proof of residency in Region VII (IL, IN, WI) (copy of ID)
- Between 18-24 years old with at least one parent of Polish descent
- Currently enrolled in an accredited college or university or High School Senior in application process
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.00 (A=4.00) as supported by an official transcript from current institution
- Need for financial assistance, as evidenced by latest Federal Income Tax return

Additional Information

- Scholarship recipients **must** attend awards ceremony or forfeit the scholarship. The Awards Ceremony will be on **Thursday, May 14, 2026, at 6:00pm** at St. Ferdinand Parish Chapel, 5900 W. Barry, Chicago.
- Recipients **MUST** attend monthly formation meetings. They are on the 3rd Sunday of each month from Sept. to June, from 2:00 to 4:30pm at Ss. Cyril & Methodius Parish in Lemont. (Sept. 20; Oct. 18; Nov. 15; Dec. 20; Jan. 17, 2027; Feb. 21; Mar. 21; Apr. 18; May 16; Jun. 13, 2027). The Committee reserves the right to change date/time if situation demands change. Before you send in the Scholarship Application, be sure you can commit to attending these meetings in person. No exceptions are allowed.
- Scholarship is pending acceptance and enrollment at qualified college/university
- St. John Paul the Great Scholarship Formation Committee, with the direction of Bishop Andrew Wypych, will review and select recipients based on defined point-based criteria. Their decision is final.
- Selected recipients will be notified by mail/email. The office cannot confirm acceptance by phone.
- Scholarship funds are sent directly to the recipient's college/university
- Scholarship could be renewed for a maximum of four years (\$5,000 per year, paid in two installments of \$2,500 each). Applicant must apply each year and meet each requirement annually.
- The Catholic League for Religious Assistance to Poland and Polonia encourages all scholarship recipients, upon graduation, to join our efforts of financially assisting young people of Polonia and sponsor, throughout their adult lives, at least one student's full scholarship.
